Dear Members and Friends of St. Paul's and Grace,

Indeed, we have much for which to give thanks this Thanksgiving, blessings in our lives, our families, our congregations. But we especially give thanks for the Lord's spiritual and eternal blessings, the CAPSTONE of all good things.

When the Greeks and Romans built their wonders of architecture, how carefully they chose the stones to put into place. It's most essential when building a stone structure to put the right stone in the right place. In the case of an arch the most important stone is top center, the capstone. Pull that stone out and the whole structure collapses.

The greatest work of architecture is God's eternal church, and the all-important capstone is Christ Jesus. One would not choose Jesus as the capstone, for in this world of riches he is too poor, in this world of glory he is too bowed down in shame, in this world of power he appears too weak.

He is the stone the builders rejected. The religious leaders who should have been building God's church crucified the Son of God, the Lord of Glory. By so doing, they were, unaware, putting the capstone into place. For in his suffering and death on the cross Jesus established his Church by paying the price for the sins of the world. Victorious over our sin, death and hell, God the Father raised him from the dead. He has become the capstone. He died to live, as he declares in our Psalm: "I will not die but live, and will proclaim what the LORD has done." He was lost to the cross and grave to be saved, as he affirms in our Psalm, "The Lord is my strength and my song; he has become my salvation....I will give you thanks,

for you answered me; you have become my salvation." Because our victor said those things as our substitute, it is appropriate and accurate for us to say them of ourselves.

And so, not only November 24, but every day is a day of thanksgiving, a day of rejoicing. Especially we thank the Lord for his salvation, that one day he will take us from this world of sorrows to himself in heaven. And we also rejoice in the earthly blessings he so freely grants us day by day. "This is the day the LORD has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it....Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good; his love endures forever."
